

Study in Australia under Stream line visa Processing (SVP)

What is Streamline Visa Processing (SVP)?

Streamlined visa processing is designed for international students applying to study in Australia at a participating university. Streamlined Visa Processing (SVP) is a new implementation from the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) that came into effect on the 24th March 2012. If an international student has a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) from a participating university, DIAC will assess that student's application quickly, as if the student were from an assessment level 1 country regardless of his/her country of birth. Streamlined visa processing means these applicants are treated as though they are lower migration risk (similar to the current Assessment Level 1) regardless of their country of origin.

Benefits to apply under streamline visa processing (SVP)

- High visa success rate
- Less visa processing time
- Dependents can accompany
- Third party can sponsor the funds
- Work up to 40 hours per fortnight while course is in session
- Dependents can work up to 40 hours per fortnight provided commencement of course of study in Australia. If a postgraduate course, such as a Masters by coursework degree, than dependents can work unlimited hours once commencement of course.
- IELTS requirement is only 5.5 band
- Intake under SVP is March, July and November
- Visa file lodgment in consulate by e-visa and paper visa
- No Interview for admission
- 3 years post study work available after completion of bachelor degree and 3 years after master degree program
